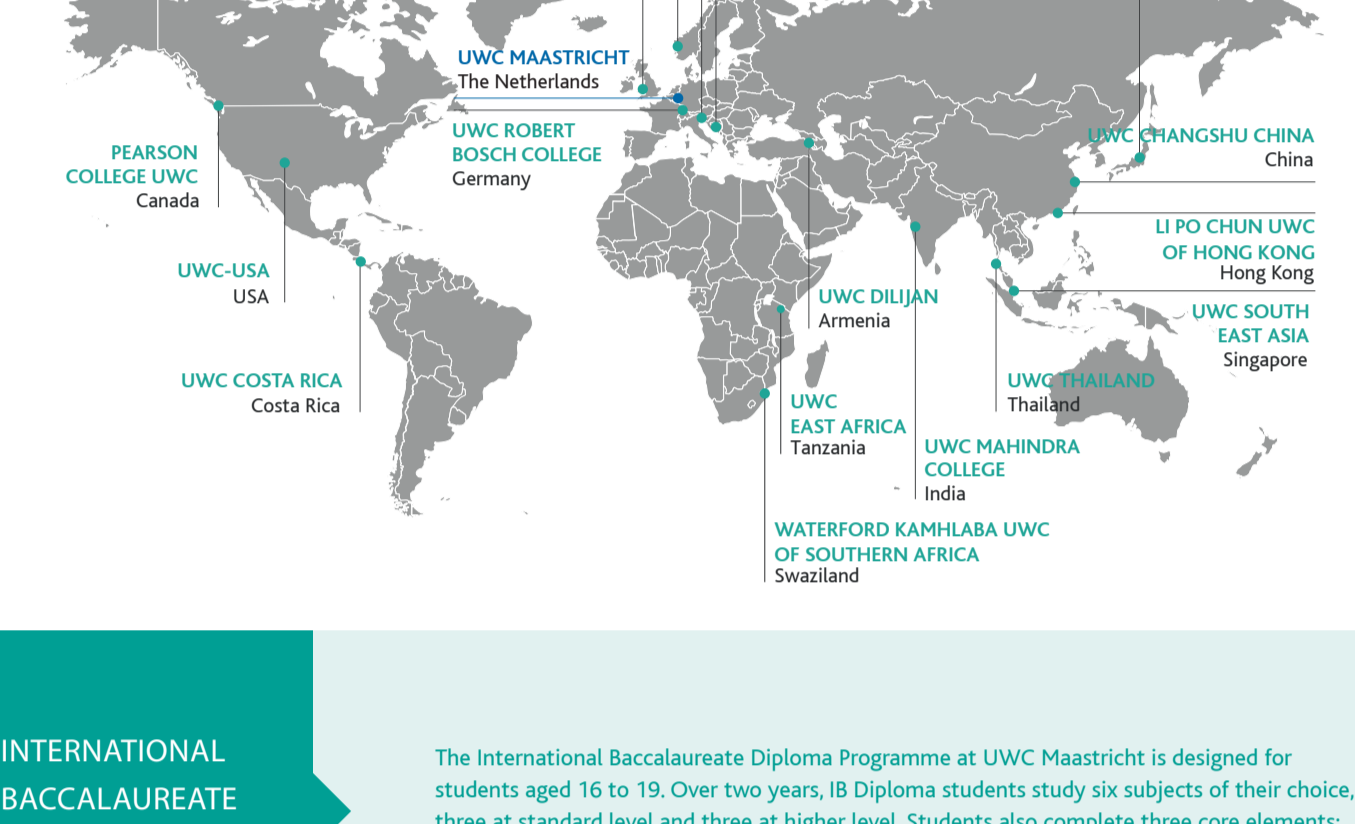

INTERNATIONAL BACCALAUREATE DIPLOMA PROGRAMME

The International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme at UWC Maastricht is designed for students aged 16 to 19. Over two years, IB Diploma students study six subjects of their choice, three at standard level and three at higher level. Students also complete three core elements: Theory of knowledge (TOK), Extended Essay (EE) and Creativity, activity, service (CAS). Subject offerings in the IB Diploma Programme:

The International Baccalaureate Curriculum in our Middle Years Programme teaches students, aged 11 – 16, both inside and outside the classroom. It ensures breadth and depth of knowledge and understanding. All MYP students choose subjects from the following eight groups:



In addition, all MYP students study Dutch language. All MYP students complete Service as Action activities and projects, such as Youth Mayors, Erasmus Project or MUN. All MYP4 students participate in The Duke of Edinburgh's International Award - Bronze. In the final year of MYP, as a way to consolidate the MYP experience, all students complete a Personal Project: an independent exploration into an area of interest, which is externally assessed. All other assessment in the MYP programme at UWC Maastricht is internal.

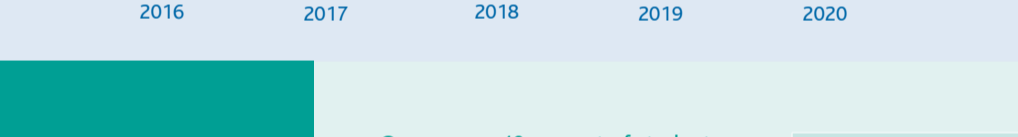

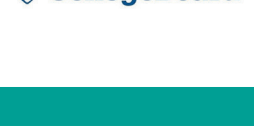
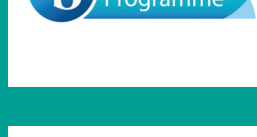
UNIVERSITY COUNSELLING POLICIES

Government mandated school closure in mid-March 2020 due to COVID-19 necessitated shifting all classes and community events to a virtual format. In-person teaching and learning resumed in June 2020 for day students and boarding students who had remained on campus or were able to travel back to The Netherlands. A significant number of students had to adapt to a change in time zone or blended teaching. UWC Maastricht reopened as normal in late August 2020, with a number of students starting the school year in quarantine conditions. Achieved and predicted grades are based on students' formal online and in-person assessments, taking into account potential disruptions.
