The IBCP is a framework of international education that incorporates the vision and educational principles of the IB into a unique programme specifically developed for students who wish to engage in careerrelated learning. IBCP students at UWC Maastricht study the SUMAS* Career-related study in Sustainable Business as well as two to four Diploma subjects selected from the list in the table above. In addition, students are required to complete four IBCP core components: Personal and Professional Skills, Service Learning, a Reflective Project and Language Development. Our first cohort of IBCP students will graduate in May 2024. *SUMAS is the Sustainable Management School, Switzerland, a Strategic Provider of Career-


