Approximately 75 percent of the Class of 2024 do not speak English as a first language and come from diverse cultural backgrounds, including some who have experienced interrupted or limited education due to migration and/or conflict. The rigorous IB Curriculum can prove particularly challenging for those students who are still developing their proficiency in English. As a result, ELL support is provided for students with a beginner to intermediate proficiency in English.

At UWC Maastricht we place a lot of importance on learning that happens outside of the classroom. As we are an IB school all of our students complete elements of CAS (Creativity, Activity and Service). We place particular importance on service and our students have access to opportunities with over 100 external service providers in Maastricht. A large number also undertake the Duke of Edinburgh's International Award, a challenging outdoor and experiential education programme. As we are an Eco School we are also working on projects involving the environment and sustainability.

CO-CURRICULAR AND EXPERIENTIAL EDUCATION

Student leadership at UWC Maastricht is fostered through opportunities like Student Council, Model United Nations, Youth Social Entrepreneurship Hub and other student-led activities. Students organize conferences and events that take place on campus throughout the year. Covering topics such as International Peace, Sustainability, Theory of Knowledge, The Arts, Science and Gender Issues. They also arrange school-wide Culture Weeks to celebrate the diversity of cultures that we have on our campus. Besides this, students are exposed to a variety of guest speakers and Debates through our Global Issues Forum.

Other opportunities for development are Critical Engagement (personal and social skill development), Project Weeks and many after school activities.

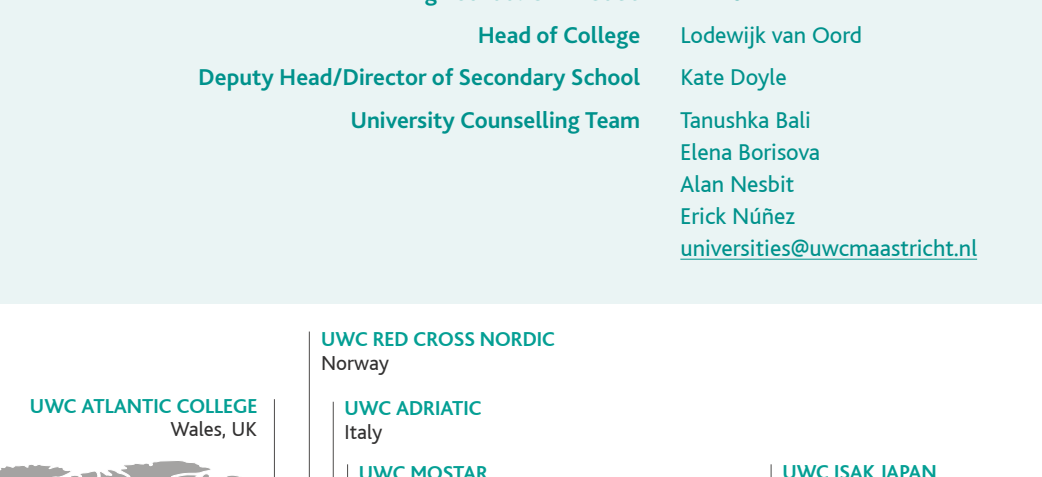

STAFF OF 2023-2024 NATIONALITIES

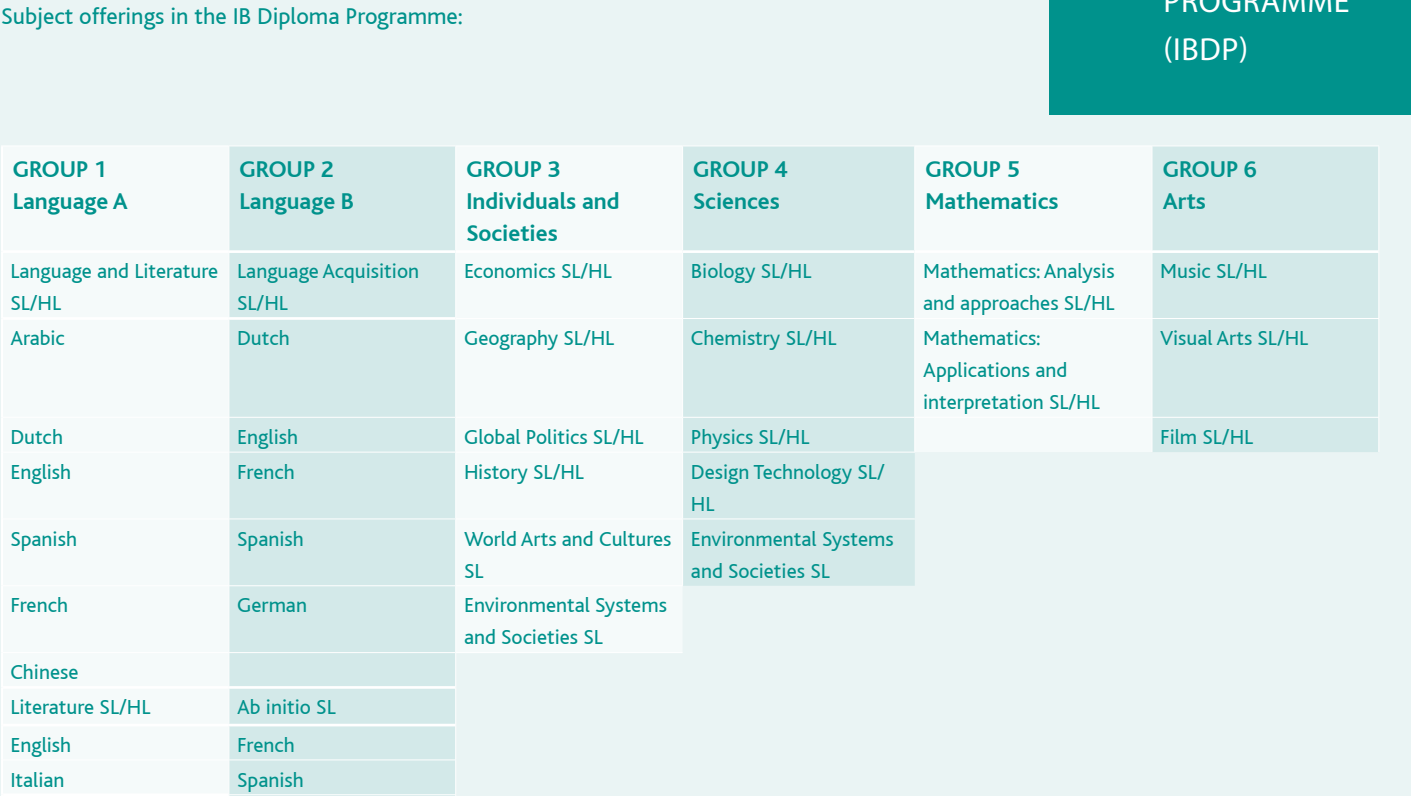

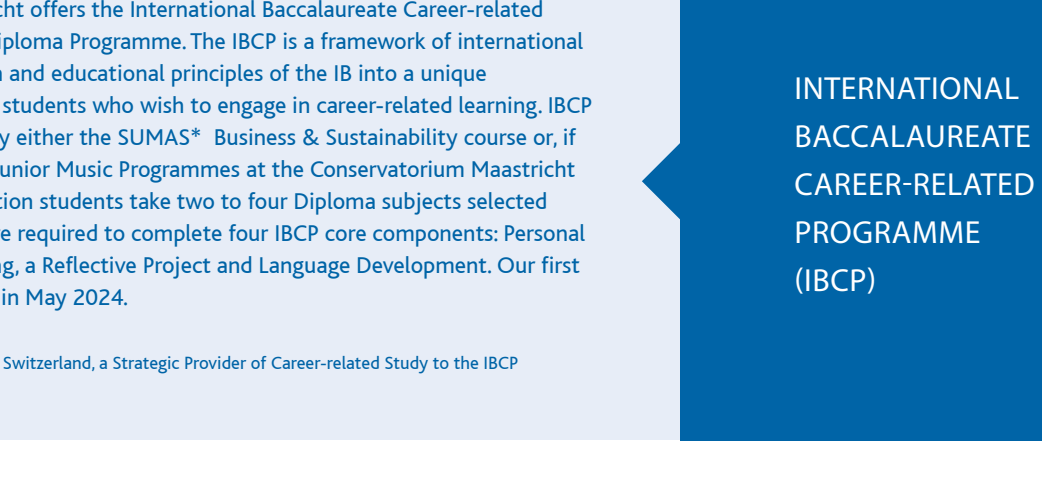

The International Baccalaureate Curriculum in our Middle Years Programme enriches students, aged 11 – 16, both inside and outside the classroom. It ensures breadth and depth of knowledge and understanding. All MYP students choose subjects from the following eight groups:



In addition, all MYP students study Dutch language. They also complete Service as Action activities and projects, such as Youth Mayors, Erasmus Project or MUN. All MYP4 students participate in The Duke of Edinburgh's International Award - Bronze. In the final year of MYP, as a way to consolidate the MYP experience, all students complete a Personal Project: an independent exploration into an area of interest, which is externally assessed. All other assessment in the MYP programme at UWC Maastricht is internal.

The International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme at UWC Maastricht is designed for students aged 16 to 19. Over two years, IB Diploma students study six subjects of their choice, three at standard level and three at higher level. Students also complete three core elements: Theory of Knowledge (TOK), Extended Essay (EE) and Creativity, Activity, Service (CAS). Subject offerings in the IB Diploma Programme:

Since September 2022, UWC Maastricht offers the International Baccalaureate Career-related Programme (IBCP), alongside the IB Diploma Programme. The IBCP is a framework of international education that incorporates the vision and educational principles of the IB into a unique programme specifically developed for students who wish to engage in career-related learning. IBCP students at UWC Maastricht can study either the SUPMAS* Business & Sustainability course or, if they are talented musicians, join the Junior Music Programmes at the Conservatorium Maastricht for their Career-related Study. In addition students take two to four Diploma subjects selected from the list in the table above and are required to complete four IBCP core components: Personal and Professional Skills, Service Learning, a Reflective Project and Language Development. Our first cohort of IBCP students will graduate in May 2024.

UWC Maastricht is an open testing centre for SAT, ACT* and Cambridge Assessment exams. On average, 25 percent of students in Years 12 and 13 take SAT or ACT each year. All scores, including those from English language learners, are recorded. *ACT is no longer offered as of 2023-24 school year.

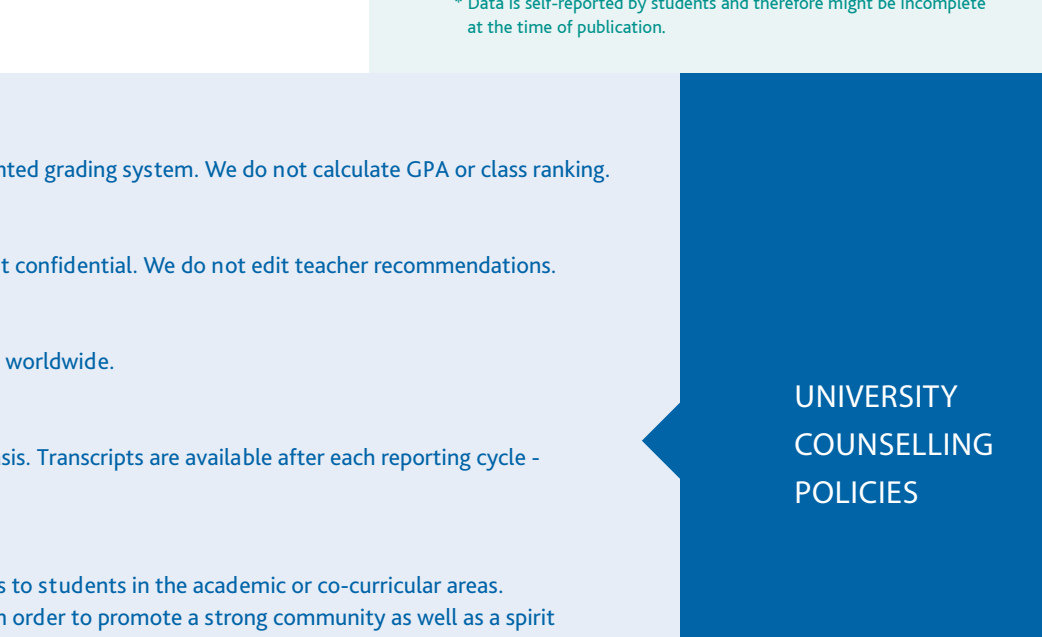

Grading system: UWC Maastricht does not use a weighted grading system. We do not calculate GPA or class ranking.

Letters of recommendation: All letters of recommendation are kept confidential. We do not edit teacher recommendations.

Applications limit: Students are limited to 8 applications worldwide.

Transcripts: The school operates on a trimester basis. Transcripts are available after each reporting cycle - in November, February and June.

Awards/Honours: UWC Maastricht does not give awards to students in the academic or co-curricular areas. This decision was deliberately taken in order to promote a strong community as well as a spirit of solidarity among students.

Test preparation: Students do not receive any type of test preparation.
