76 percent of the Class of 2025 do not speak English as their first language and come from diverse cultural backgrounds, including some who have faced interruptions or limitations in their education due to migration and/or conflict. The rigorous IB curriculum can be especially challenging for students still developing their English proficiency. Therefore, ELL support is offered to those with beginner to intermediate levels of English proficiency.

At UWC Maastricht, we place great importance on learning beyond the classroom. As an IB school, all students participate in CAS (Creativity, Activity, and Service), with a strong emphasis on service. Our students have access to over 100 external service opportunities in Maastricht and many also take part in the Duke of Edinburgh's International Award, a challenging outdoor and experiential education programme. As an Eco School, we are actively involved in environmental and sustainability projects.

Student leadership is nurtured through platforms such as the Student Council, Model United Nations, the Youth Social Entrepreneurship Programme, Student Led Initiatives and many more. Throughout the year, students organize on-campus conferences and events focused on topics like International Peace, Sustainability, Theory of Knowledge, The Arts, Science and Gender Issues. They also lead school-wide Culture Weeks to celebrate the diverse cultures within our community. Additionally, students benefit from guest speakers and debates through our Global Issues Forum.

Other opportunities for development include Critical Engagement (focusing on personal and social skills), Project Weeks and a variety of after-school activities.

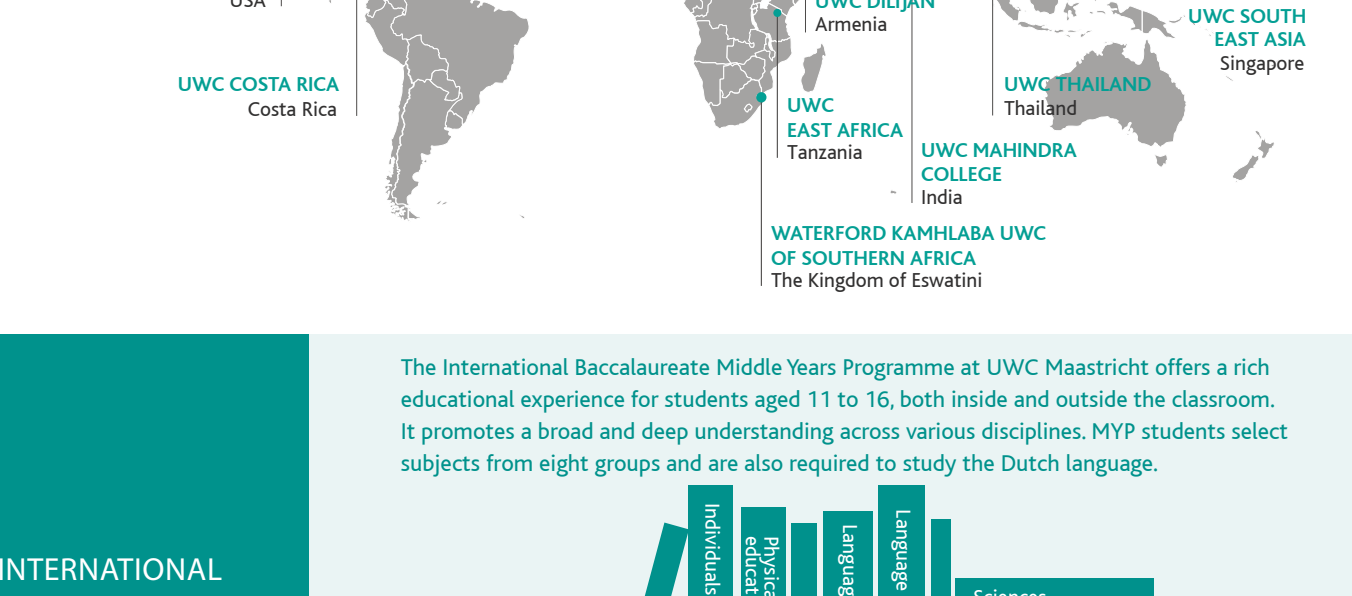
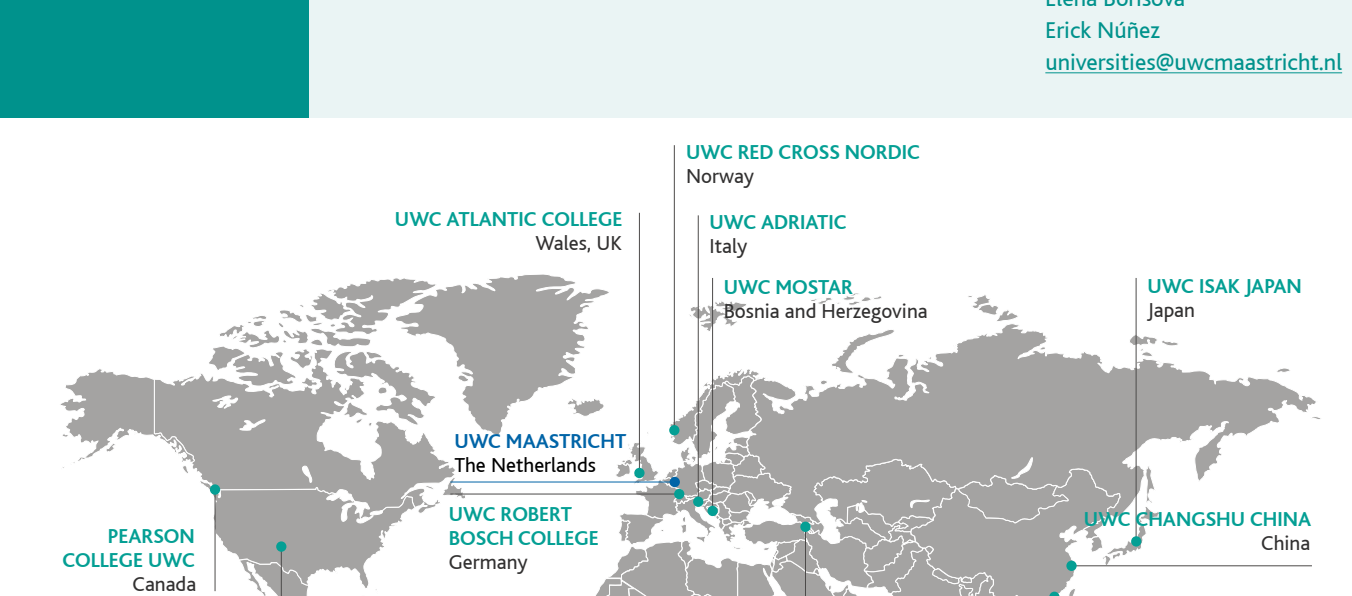

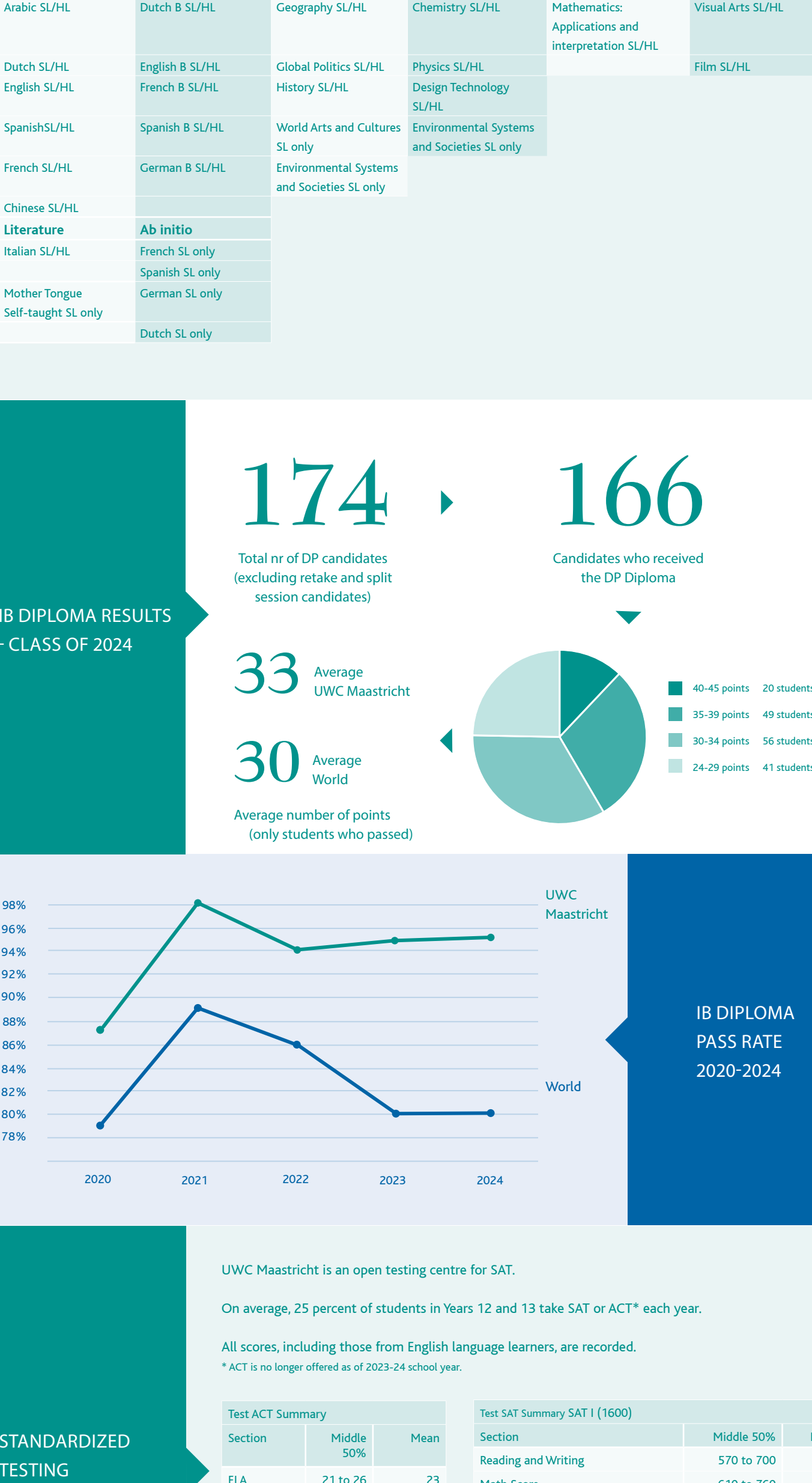

INTERNATIONAL BACCALAUREATE MIDDLE YEARS PROGRAMME (IBMYP)

The International Baccalaureate Middle Years Programme at UWC Maastricht offers a rich educational experience for students aged 11 to 16, both inside and outside the classroom. It promotes a broad and deep understanding across various disciplines. MYP students select subjects from eight groups and are also required to study the Dutch language.

As part of the programme, students engage in Service as Action activities and projects, such as Youth Mayors or Model United Nations (MUN). In MYP4, all students participate in The Duke of Edinburgh's International Award at the Bronze level. In their final year, students complete a Personal Project, an independent exploration of an area of interest, which is externally assessed. All other assessments in the MYP at UWC Maastricht are conducted internally.

The International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme at UWC Maastricht is designed for students aged 16 to 19. Over two years, IB Diploma students study six subjects of their choice, three at standard level and three at higher level. Students also complete three core elements: Theory of Knowledge (TOK), Extended Essay (EE) and Creativity, Activity, Service (CAS). Subject offerings in the IB Diploma Programme:

INTERNATIONAL BACCALAUREATE CAREER-RELATED PROGRAMME (IBCP)

Since 2022, UWC Maastricht has offered the International Baccalaureate Career-related Programme (IBCP) alongside the IB Diploma Programme. The IBCP is designed for those seeking an immersive, career-focused experience. In this programme, students specialize in either Business & Sustainability or Music, aligning with their professional aspirations. Alongside up to four IB DP subjects, the curriculum combines academic excellence with the development of personal and professional skills, providing a customized pathway to a dynamic career.
